

Parenting Coordination Training is a 24 hour program that provides the training component for professionals who would like to serve as Parenting Coordinators for the family court. This program will follow the content areas specified in Florida Statute 61.125. Participants are responsible for determining if they meet the other requirements set forth in the statute. In addition, each Florida Judicial Circuit may have other qualifications that must be met. Participants are encouraged to be familiar with the required qualifications in the circuit in which they would like to practice.

Already trained Parenting Coordinators can attend 4 hours of training on Friday morning covering domestic violence.

Parenting Coordination Training will be provided by experienced Parenting Coordinators and a presiding family judge who was instrumental in bringing a Parenting Coordination program to Orange County.
